Thursday 30th March - Easter Reading Coffee Morning. (More information about timings will be set out on Monday afternoon next week.)

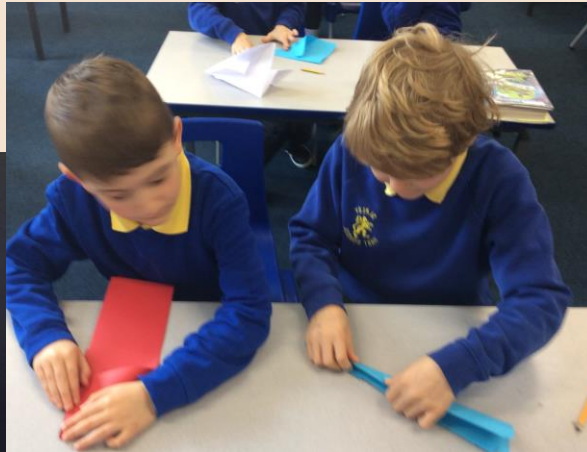
Monday April 17th - Swimming Starts for Class 1 and 2 children
