What a busy week we have had! The children have taken well to outdoor learning on a Tuesday. On **Tuesday 11th November**, Radio 2's Sara Cox will be running through our area in support of BBC Children in Need. *Sara's Great Northern Marathon Challenge* is Radio 2's longest ever run and will be taking place over five consecutive days, covering 135 miles (five marathons). Sara will be starting at Kielder Forest and finishing in Pudsey, Leeds to celebrate 40 years of Pudsey Bear.

We would like to take the children to watch this special event and will be walking to the top of the village to cheer Sara on as she passes. The walk will be supervised by school staff and all safety procedures will be carefully followed. We have also been told that Pudsey Bear himself may even make an appearance! Throughout Sara's marathon journey, she will be followed by a documentary film crew and there is a possibility that the children may appear on camera as she runs past. We therefore require your permission for your child to take part in this outing and to potentially be filmed. A letter has been sent home today Asking for permission for your child to take part in this event (or not) please could you return school by Monday. I have also attached another letter with this email.
