Tea and biscuits will be on offer!

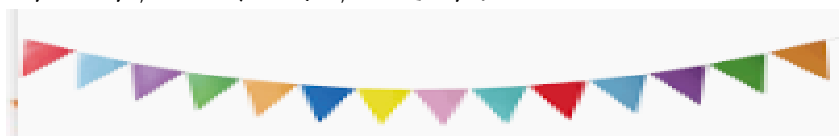
